GENERAL EDUCATION GUIDELINES

General education is 40 credits. Each of the twelve outcomes (A1-D1) must be met by at least 3 credits. A single course may meet more than one outcome but cannot be double counted towards the 40-credit total. At least one course must be a Grand Challenge (G). No more than twelve credits can have the same course code (note - HPR courses may have more than 12 credits). General education courses may also be used to meet requirements of the major or minor when appropriate.

Step 2:

At least 40 credits, no more than 12 credits with the same course code.
